### **ISN SANSKRITI-THE ART FESTIVAL 2017-18**

#### **General Rules and regulations:**

- Only positive social themes can be presented. Care should be taken not to present any religious/political/controversial themes.
- The theme, songs, costumes and make-up should be appropriate for school competitions and respect the culture and traditions of the country of residence and India. During screening of CDs, songs with inappropriate lyrics will be cancelled and the student will be asked to bring another song with appropriate lyrics.
- In case of any technical problems during the performance, the participant will be given another chance to perform once again.
- The actions of smokers, drunkards, beggars or any negative roles are not allowed.
- Do not hurt the sentiments of any religion, culture or nationality. Performances ridiculing individuals or religious sentiments are not allowed and will be disqualified.
- Participants should be present one hour before their events and collect their chest numbers without delay from the allotted rooms.
- Separate green rooms will be allotted for boys and girls.
- Parents are requested not to crowd behind and near the stage premises. In case required, one parent representative along with student volunteers will be permitted to set the stage.
- Parents are requested not to crowd in the various rooms allotted for giving chest numbers.
- Parents and students will not be permitted to move around the allotted area for judges.
- Judges will be strictly following only the criteria given in the rules and regulations uploaded on the website. Anything apart from these, like background settings, will not be counted. Parents are requested to refrain from spending time in preparing props for background settings.
- There will be a separate room for the judges and two tabulators (Mathematics Department).
- The final compilation of the marks will be done by the tabulators and the final result sheet will be signed by all the three judges. Final result will be rechecked by the programme coordinators.
- Computerised tabulation will be done by the tabulators.
- Each Participant for group events will be given individual chest numbers for the convenience to select the probable candidates to be shortlisted for the ISN Jhankar Spectrum Team. This is applicable only for Group dance, Mime, Street play. For other events prize winners will be considered.
- The decision of the judges and of the school with regard to ISN SANSKRITI- THE ART FESTIVAL will be final and binding.
