Rules and Regulations

FANCY DRESS

- Maximum time allotted for performance is up to one minute.
- Monologues / dialogues, audio / video etc. are not allowed.
- Participant should directly enter the stage without any support from a second person.
- Do not use explosive, sharp items, banners and backdrops, etc. as props. Stage setting will also be not allowed.
- No religious deity to be enacted and do not hurt the sentiments of any religion, culture or nationality.
- Enacting smokers, drunkards, beggars or such negative acts / costumes are not allowed.
- The costumes chosen must strictly be age-appropriate and child-friendly.
- The participants will be judged for their costumes, expression & gestures, confidence, creativity, presentation, and overall appeal.

ACTION SONG

- Maximum time allotted is five minutes.
- Minimum number of participants is six and maximum is eight.
- The lyrics, song, choreography, costumes and make-up should be appropriate for school-level competitions and respect the culture and tradition of our country and the country of residence.
- Karaoke/background music is allowed.
- Participants will be judged for their choice of song, costumes, rhythm, coordination, action, and overall presentation.

FOLK DANCE – SOLO

- Maximum time allotted is four minutes.
- The lyrics, song, choreography, costumes and make-up should be appropriate for school-level competitions and respect the culture and tradition of our country and the country of residence.
- Song and dance must be Indian traditional folk ONLY.
- Film songs are not permitted.
- Participants will be judged for rhythm & synchronization, energy & stage coverage, entry & exit, presentation, and performance quality.

GROUP DANCE

- Maximum time allotted is five minutes.
- Minimum number of participants is six and maximum ten.
- Film songs/classical /semi classical/folk songs are allowed.
- The lyrics, song, choreography, costumes and make-up should be appropriate for school-level competitions and respect the culture and tradition of our country and the country of residence.
- Participants will be judged for their costumes & accessories, rhythm & synchronization, presentation, song selection, entry, exit and choreography.
