- ❖ The entry should be in video format and there may be more than one entry from one school.
- ❖ Videos exceeding 20 seconds will be disqualified.
- ❖ Details of participant (name, name of school, name of country, a copy of the school ID card of the participant and a copy of birth certificate) should be attached along with the video.
- ❖ Voicing and pronunciation must be clear in the video recording
- ❖ Derogatory and vulgar language will not be accepted.
- ❖ The WHS will have the copyright of the video and reserves the right to post the video on its website.
- ❖ The decision of the Jury will be final and irrevocable.

### Instructions for submission of video

- Video must be renamed as the participant's name as written in the prescribed form.
- Details of participant should be submitted in the prescribed form.
- Video should not exceed 20 seconds and should be in landscape format (1280 x 720) or MP4.Mov format

- Videos can be sent via Google Drive or WeTransfer online file transfer service. Entries must reach the WHS by e-mail latest by Monday 02 February 2026.
