Academic Excellence Award: Rules and Guidelines-2026-27

1. Eligibility

- A student who misses either the **Mid-Term** or **Final Examination** will **not** be eligible for the Academic Excellence Award.
- If a student is absent for **both the Pre-Midterm and Post-Midterm assessments**, he/she will remain eligible for Academic Excellence. However, the score for that criterion will be recorded as **0**.

2. Marking Policy

- **Rounding off of marks** will be applied **only** for the Mid-Term and Final Examinations.
- For all other assessments, marks will be recorded **up to two decimal places**.

3. Pre/ Post Mid-Term Assessment

- For Academic Excellence, the best of pre/post midterm mark will be taken.
- If a student is absent from one of these two, then the mark of present one will be taken.

4. Final Calculation

For Classes V to VIII

Subjects considered for Academic Excellence: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies.

CALCULATION:

Pre/ Post mid-term (best) - 25

Mid-term - 80 + 20 (**20 marks as per the Half Yearly Report Card**)

Final - 80 + 20 (**20 marks as per the Final Report Card**)

Total 225 per subject x 4 = 900

Percentage: $\frac{\text{Marks obtained}}{900} \times 100$

Award Categories:

- Top 3 students (highest percentages in each class): **Toppers**
- Students scoring above 90%: **Merit Holders**
- **Second/Third Language (SL/TL):**
 - For each language (Hindi, Malayalam, Arabic, Sanskrit, Tamil), the topper will receive **an Excellence Certificate.**

SL Calculation: Pre/Post midterm (best) – 25

Mid-term - 80 + 20 (**20 marks as per the Half Yearly Report Card**)

Final - 80 + 20 (**20 marks as per the Final Report Card**)

Total: 225

- **TL Calculation:** Pre/Post midterm (best) – 25
- Mid-term – 50 + 20 (**20 marks as per the Half Yearly Report Card**)
Final – 50 +20 (**20 marks as per the Final Report Card**)

Total: 165

CLASS IX:

- **Subjects considered:** English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies
- **Calculation:**
 - Pre/Post Midterm (best): 40
 - Mid-Term: 80 + 20
 - Final: 80 + 20
 - **Total = 240 per subject × 4 = 960**
 - Percentage: $\frac{\text{Marks obtained}}{960} \times 100$

For Second language [Hindi, Malayalam, Arabic, Sanskrit, Tamil] for each language, the topper will be awarded with **excellence certificate**.

- **SL - pre/ post (best) - 40**
- Mid-term - 100
- Final - 100
- **Total : 240**

CLASS XI

Calculation (subject-wise):

- Pre/Post Midterm (best): 40 or 35
 - Midterm: 80+20 or 70+30
 - Final: 80+20 or 70+30
 - Total = 240 or 235 (depending on subject)
-
- **80-mark subjects: English, Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics**
 - **70-mark subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Informatics Practices**

Percentage: $\frac{\text{Marks obtained}}{\text{Total Marks}} \times 100$
