Academic Excellence Award: Rules and Guidelines-2025-'26

Academic excellence awards for classes V to IX and XI, for the academic year 2025-'26 will be given after the commencement of the next academic year. The guidelines which will be followed for awarding the students are as follows:

Eligibility

- A student who misses either the Mid-Term or Final Examination will not be eligible for the Academic Excellence Award.
- If a student is absent for both the Pre-Midterm and Post-Midterm assessments, he/she will remain eligible for Academic Excellence. However, the score for that criterion will be recorded as zero.

Marking Policy

- Rounding off of marks will be applied only for the Mid-Term and Final Examinations.
- For all other assessments, marks will be rounded up to two decimal places.

Pre/ Post Mid-Term Assessment

- For Academic Excellence, the best of pre/post midterm mark will be taken.
- If a student is absent from one of these two, then the mark of present one will be taken.

Classes V to VIII

<u>Subjects considered for Academic Excellence</u>: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies.

CALCULATION:

- ➤ Pre/ Post mid-term (best) 25marks
- ➤ Mid-term 80 (Written Exam) + 20 (Internal)
- > Final 80 (Written Exam) + 20 (Internal)

Total: 225 per subject x 4 = 900.

Percentage: $\frac{Marks\ obtained}{900} \times 100$

Award Categories:

- Top 3 students (highest percentages in each class): **Toppers**
- Students scoring above 90%: Merit Holders

Second/Third Language (SL/TL):

For each language (Hindi, Malayalam, Arabic, Sanskrit, Tamil), the topper will receive an Excellence Certificate, as the difficulty level of the languages vary.

Second Language Calculation:

- ➤ Pre/Post midterm (best) 25 marks
- ➤ Midterm 100 marks

Final: $100 \rightarrow \text{Total}$: 225

Third Language Calculation:

- ➤ Pre/Post midterm (best) 25 marks
- ➤ Midterm 50 marks

Final: $50 \rightarrow \text{Total}$: 125

CLASS IX

Subjects considered: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies

Calculation:

- > Pre/Post Midterm (best): 40 marks
- ➤ Mid-Term: 80 (Written Exam) + 20 (Internal)

Final: 80 (Written Exam) + 20 (Internal)

Total = 240 per subject \times 4 = 960

Percentage: $\frac{Marks\ obtained}{960} \times 100$

<u>Second language</u> (Hindi, Malayalam, Arabic, Sanskrit, Tamil) for each language, the topper will be awarded with <u>excellence certificate</u>.

- \triangleright SL pre/ post (best) 40 marks
- ➤ Mid-term 100 marks

Final – 100 marks

Total: 240

Calculation (subject-wise):

➤ Midterm: 80+20 or 70+30

Final: 80+20 or 70+30

Total = 240 or 235 (depending on subject)

√ 80-mark subjects: English, Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics

✓ 70-mark subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Informatics Practices
