## ARTICLES- A, An, The

Articles are words that come before nouns. The articles are **a**, **an**, and **the**.

### a) Rules for 'a' and 'an'

We use "a" before a singular common noun that begins with a **consonant sound**.

Examples: **a** book, **a** cat, **a** table, **a** tree.

We use "an" before a singular common noun that begins with a **vowel sound** (a, e, i, o, u).

Examples: **an** apple, **an** egg, **an** ice cream, **an** orange, **an** umbrella.

### b) Rules for 'the'

1. We use "**the**" when we are talking about a **specific** noun.

"**The** sun rises in the east."

"**The** moon is bright tonight."
