- 1 Many new dynasties emerged after **seventh** century.
 - 2 As samantas gained power and wealth, they declared themselves to be **maha-samanta, maha-mandaleshvara**
 - 3 In mid eight, Dantidurga, a **Rashtrakuta** chief, overthrew his Chalukya overlord.
 - 4 Prashastis were composed by **Brahmanas**
 - 5 Settlements of peasants, known as **Ur** became prosperous with the spread of irrigation agriculture.
 - 6 Brahmanas often received land grants called as **Brahmadeya**.
 - 7 Dantidurga performed a ritual called **hiranya-garbha** and came to be known as kshatriya.
 - 8 Many of the new kings adopted high-sounding titles such as **maharaja-adhiraja** or **tribhuvana-chakravartin** and so on.
 - 9 Kalhana wrote a long poem in Sanskrit containing the history of kings who ruled over **Kashmir**.
 - 10 The long conflict of Gurjara-Pratihara, Rashtrakuta and Pala for the control over Kanauj is called '**tripartite struggle**.'
 - 11 Prithviraja III was a Chahamanan ruler who defeated an Afghan ruler named **Sultan Muhammed Ghori**.
 - 12 The temples of Thanjavur and Gangaikonda-cholapuram were built by **Rajaraja** and **Rajendra I**
 13. **Al Biruni** wrote Kitab ul Hind
 14. **Prashastis** contained details of rulers, depicting them as valiant, victorious warriors.
 - 15 **Mahmud of Ghazni** raided the subcontinent almost every year and targeted wealthy temples, including Somnath in Gujarat.
 16. In Chola kingdom, groups of villages formed larger units known as **nadu**.
 17. In the Chola kingdom, the association of traders were known as **nagarams**.
 - 18 Amongst the crafts associated with the temples the making of **bronze images** was the most distinctive in Chola kingdom.
 - 19 **Vijayalaya** who belonged to the family of the Cholas from Uraiyur, captured Kaveri delta from the Muttaraiyar.
 - 20 The grants of land rewarded to the Brahmanas were recorded on **copper plates**.
