Demonstratives are words that are used to point out specific people, places, or things. The four demonstratives in English are **this, that, these, and those**. They can function as either a pronoun or a determiner, indicating whether something is near or far, as well as whether it is singular or plural. Demonstratives are also used to point out specific people or things and indicate whether they are near or far.
